# Surgical hand disinfection

Pour at least 5 ml **AHD 2000**<sup>®</sup> in the palm of the hands and rub on hands and forearms until dry, giving particular attention to the fingertips and to the areas around the nails. Duration: 1 1/2 min. each.

#### Hygienic hand rub

(Also appropriate for use according to §18 of the German Law for the prevention of infectious diseases (IfSG)

Keep hands wet by the concentrated

product during the whole exposure time: concentrated at least 3 ml - 30 sec

#### Skin disinfection

Wet the area to be disinfected completely with **AHD 2000**<sup>®</sup> and allow to dry completely, especially before using thermo-electrical appliances on the skin.

Before punctures and injections concentrated at least 15 sec;

Before punctures of articulations, body cavities,

hollow organs, and before surgery concentrated at least 1 min

On skin with a lot of sebaceous glands (for ex. forehead): concentrated at least 1 min

Virucidal\* against enveloped viruses incl. HBV/HCV/HIV,

Rota virus and Adeno virus concentrated - 30 sec

The use of AHD 2000<sup>®</sup> on children has not been sufficiently studied. Use this product on babies and small children only under medical supervision. However no side effects are to be expected if the product is used as recommended.

Hypersensitivity to one or several components

# Pregnancy and lactation

Can be used during pregnancy and lactation if used adequately

#### Side-effects

Especially by frequent use the skin might become dry and irritated (reddening, burning feeling). Allergic reactions are very seldom: (<0.01 % or not known). #### Warnings / storage

- Do not store above 25 °C, keep drugs out of reach of children and away from ignition sources.
- Do not use beyond expiry date.
